BASIS OF CONVENTIONAL AND BIOLOGICAL IMMUNOTHERAPIES

Modifications of the requirements due to state of emergency caused by the SARS-Cov2 epidemic valid for the 2nd semester of academic year 2019/2020.

Live online lectures in form of webinars are not held. Lecturers of the course have uploaded tools and material that help students to learn the material individually. Students are encouraged to request live online consultations directly from the lecturer of the current topic for each week. Online materials include a .ppt file with slides, review articles summarizing the topic/field, and primary papers from which students can choose one for their end-term exam.

It is requested that once the student have chosen a topic and a paper to be presented at the end-tem exam the she/he should contact the lecturer of the topic and request a consultation and discuss the subject.

End term exam:

As previously, students are required to chose a topic and a paper from the course material that they analyze in depth by themselves, and present. Due to the SARS-Covid epidemic instead of an oral presentation students should submit the critical analysis of the chosen paper in writing. The writing will be a word or a PDF document that contains a minimum of 1500 characters, the figures of the paper and the critical review of the chosen publication. No upper character limit was set. The document must be sent electronically to the course coordinator for evaluation (grades 1-5) no later than the last day of the exam period.
